REQUIREMENTS TO BE IN FFA

- 1. Students entering the Pathways program will be interviewed to address interest and intent to participate.
- 2. Students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA to participate and remain in the program.
- 3. Behavioral citations will exclude the student from the program.
- 4. Student must commit to the Pathways program no later than semester 2 of their freshmen year.
- 5. Being enrolled in an Ag class requires a 10\$ fee to be an FFA member
