Presidential Scholarship for the Class of 2031

The Garces Memorial High School Presidential Scholarship is awarded to (3) incoming 9th grade students that have demonstrated excellence in academics, community or parish service, leadership in school and outstanding character. This scholarship is renewable over the four years at Garces Memorial if this high standard is maintained. The \$3,500 scholarship is to be applied to tuition.

Scholarship Requirements based on Garces Memorial's Four Pillars:

- Knowledge: Minimum GPA of 3.65
- Faith: Must be involved in serving their community and parish or church
- Justice: Conduct must be exemplary
- Compassion: Must be involved in extracurricular activities within their current school

How to Apply:

Eligible applicants are required to submit a 1-2 page personal essay about why you would like to attend Garces and how you are involved in your school, community and church. Applicants should also submit a copy of their most recent report card as well as an academic letter of recommendation from their school. The essay and recommendation should address how the applicant has demonstrated academic excellence, community or parish service, leadership in school and outstanding character.

Students that meet the scholarship requirements and submit their application by the **November 17th** early commitment deadline will be considered for the Presidential Scholarship. All eligible applicants will be reviewed by the Garces Memorial Administration Team. This scholarship will be presented to the recipient at their 8th grade graduation (pending approval of school) by a Garces Memorial official.
