Criteria for applying for the Garces Memorial Alumni Scholarship:

1. The student/family must have applied and qualified for tuition assistance/financial aid through Garces Memorial's FACTS program.
2. The student must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.
3. The student must be a child or grandchild of a Garces alumnus.
4. The student must demonstrate involvement at Garces by participating on at least one extra-curricular activity on an annual basis.
5. The student must be Catholic or in the process of becoming Catholic.
