Job Title: Daytime Security Reports to: Dean of Students Compensation: \$18/hour

Daytime security personnel report directly to the Dean of Students, and are responsible for the overall security of the Garces Memorial High School (GMHS) campus to ensure the safety of students, faculty, and staff, and the protection of school property. Security personnel will accomplish this through the following job duties:

Responsibilities:

- Shift start time will be at 7:30 am or 8:00 am, depending on the assignment.
- Monitor gates and access points before school start time.
- Monitor the athletic facilities and the west end of campus.
- Close and lock all perimeter gates after the morning school bell rings.
- Supervise students during morning break and lunchtime in Monsignor Leddy hall and the general quad area.
- Conduct school perimeter checks throughout the day.
 - Ensure no points along the perimeter fence have been breached or are damaged.
- Escort students, who are dismissed, to perimeter gates to ensure gates are locked and secured upon their departure.
- Assist, per the GMHS Emergency Operation Plan, with school safety drills, and emergencies.
- Assist the Dean of Students with emergency operations training of students, faculty, and staff.
- Conduct patrols of school parking lots.
- Assist with security at home football games.
- Other duties as assigned.
