The Starting Line:

FFA has five degrees a member can receive, the Discovery degree, Greenhand degree, Chapter degree, State degree and the American degree.

The discovery degree is awarded to students who are in seventh or eighth grade and are enrolled in agricultural classes as well as pay dues to their FFA chapter. This degree is not needed in order to pursue a Greenhand degree, but if it is offered in your state, it is a great way to jumpstart your FFA career.

The Greenhand FFA Degree is awarded to ninth grade or older members who learn about the FFA history, mission, creed and emblem and make plans for an SAE.The opportunities to succeed are LIMITLESS in Garces' FFA

The Chapter FFA Degree is awarded to members in lOth grade or higher who are involved in chapter activities and community service and complete the minimum hours of instruction and SAE project growth.

The State FFA Degree is awarded by State Associations and is open to members in 11th grade or higher who are involved in chapter leadership, state-level activities and community service, and who complete a set number of hours of instruction and SAE growth and productivity. AT Garces in order to earn your chords when walking the stage you must earn and achieve your state degree.

American FFA Degree Qualifications: Have been FFA members for at least three years. Have completed at least three years (540 hours) of high school agriculture classes, or 2 years of high school agriculture classes and one year of college agriculture classes (360 hours.) Finish Line!






WHY GET A FFA DEGREE
