

# HOW TO JOIN FFA

## FRESHMEN

If you are a freshman looking to join FFA, you will first want to talk to the freshman counselor about adding Ag to your schedule. From there you will need to print and fill out the class form on the Garces website ([garces.org](http://garces.org)), which can be found by clicking Academics, then Counseling, and then clicking on your graduating year. As a freshman you will be enrolled in Agriculture Food and Natural Resources. This class can act as a replacement for the freshman physics requirement if you remain in the program for all four years.



## SOPHOMORES

If you are a sophomore looking to join FFA, you will need to talk to your designated counselor about adding Ag to your schedule. From there you will need to print and fill out the class form on the Garces website ([garces.org](http://garces.org)), which can be found by clicking Academics, then Counseling, and then clicking on your graduating year. Sophomores are given the choice between joining Agriculture Food and Natural Resources or Floral Design, however it is highly recommended that you start with AFNR.



## JUNIORS

If you are a junior looking to join FFA, you will need to talk to your designated counselor about adding Ag to your schedule. From there you will need to print and fill out the class form on the Garces website ([garces.org](http://garces.org)), which can be found by clicking Academics, then Counseling, and then clicking on your graduating year. Juniors are given the choice between joining Agriculture Food and Natural Resources, Floral Design, or Ag Sales and Marketing. It is highly recommended that all new members start in AFNR.

## SENIORS

If you are a senior looking to join FFA, you will need to talk to your designated counselor about adding Ag to your schedule. From there you will need to print and fill out the class form on the Garces website ([garces.org](http://garces.org)), which can be found by clicking Academics, then Counseling, and then clicking on your graduating year. Seniors will be enrolled in Ag Sales and Marketing.
