REQUIREMENTS FOR SAE

- Greenhand degree/Freshmen: 50 hours, no required profit
- Chapter degree/Sophomore: 100 hours (combined), and/or \$150 profit
- State degree/Junior: 500 hours (combined), and/or \$1000 profit
- American degree/Senior: 540 hours, and/or \$10,000 profit
